The following criteria will be used to determine with which of the 12 booster clubs a youth should participate. When entering the Davidson County Recreation program, each youth has a choice to participate with the Booster club that represents the public elementary school district in which he/she lives or if the child attends a different public elementary school, he/she may participate with the booster club of that district. Once a child's booster club is determined, his/her eligibility would change only if there is a change in the following:

\* WHERE HE/SHE LIVES OR \* WHICH PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL HE/SHE ATTENDS

NOTE: the domicile of their legal guardian (with whom the child lives) living in Davidson County will determine A youth's resident status.

Elementary school District is the standard graduation of elementary to middle to high school all within the same district.

It is the responsibility of each local booster club to verify both the school attendance/residency requirements and the parent/guardian signature on this form. The Davidson County Recreation Department reserves the right to review any registration forms and declares ineligible any participant who has given false information.

This form will serve as your receipt and uniform order form. The Southwood Booster Club is a non-profit organization, all officers of the club and coaches are volunteers, not paid employees, so your cooperation is requested. The SBC does carry an insurance policy on each of the participants during the season of play. Club officers, volunteers, and coaches cannot be held personally liable in the event of an accident. **Uniforms will be ordered within a week of the last sign-up, after this time absolutely NO refunds will be remitted.**

LEAGUE CONDUCT RULES  
NO TOLERANCE POLICY

- A. Due to the many concerns and the national attention brought to sportsmanship, the Department has taken a proactive no tolerance stand towards any unsportsmanlike act or conduct.
- B. A team, team member, coach or spectator may be disqualified from play or the area for any of the various infractions listed below:
  - 1. Ejection from a game will result in an automatic (2) game suspension for the first offense. Second offense is automatic suspension from league. All suspensions will roll over into the next season.
  - 2. Using flagrant obscene language or displaying flagrant actions considered as unsportsmanlike gestures or other unsportsmanlike conduct. Penalty – (2) two game suspension for first offense. Second offense is automatic suspension from league. All suspensions will roll over into the next season.
  - 3. Physical violence involving a player, coach, spectator, scorekeeper or official during time of play, preceding or following a game. Automatic season suspension.
  - 4. Verbal threats or harassment made by a player, spectator, or coach directed to another player, coach, spectator, or game official. Penalty – (1) one game suspension for first offense. Second offense is automatic suspension from league. All suspensions will roll over into the next season.
  - 5. Use of tobacco or alcoholic beverages is prohibited on or around all Davidson County facilities or team members. Penalty - (2) two game suspension for first offense. Second offense is automatic suspension from league. All suspensions will roll over into the next season.
  - 6. Failure to provide Davidson County, officials, supervisors and/or proper club authorities with the name(s) of player(s), coach(es) or spectator(s) involved in any infraction when requested to do so. Penalty – (2) two game suspension for first offense. Second offense is automatic suspension from league. All suspensions will roll over into the next season.
  - 7. Any player, coach, spectator, official, scorekeeper, or supervisor who brings any firearm or weapon that is not a Law Officer into any County facility or park. Penalty automatic indefinite suspension from all county sponsored events.
  - 8. Coaches, Supervisors, and Officials MUST stand at mid-court/field and supervise teams shaking hands (if teams are going to shake hands) at the end of games. Anyone acting in an unsportsmanlike manner. Penalty (2) two game suspension for first offense. Second offense is automatic suspension from league. All suspensions will roll over into the next season.
- C. Davidson County Parks & Recreation Department has instructed the officials to issue this warning to teams at the pre-game conference.
  - 1. Players and coaches, who use foul language that can be clearly heard by spectators, coaches or officials will be ejected without any additional warning.
  - 2. Player, coaches or spectators displaying unsportsmanlike conduct will be ejected without any additional warning.
  - 3. Coaches and Booster Clubs are responsible for team or fans actions directed towards league officials. Coaches or Booster Clubs will be given one (1) verbal warning for spectator conduct. For everyone's safety and enjoyment, it is important for you to control the problems a few players, coaches, or spectators may create.

NOTE: ANY OF THE ABOVE PENALTIES MAY INCLUDE A PROBATION PERIOD AND BOOSTER CLUBS MAY IMPOSE GREATER PENALTIES.
